I request that all Principals/Directors should take action by issuing necessary instructions to all the faculty members of your pertinent college(s) to curb ragging and make this Academic Year 2011-12 as **Ragging-Free Year**.

You are aware that the Apex Court and the University Grants Commission have evolved guidelines/Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions. The same were circulated in the First Meeting of the State Level Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell held on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2010 wherein His Excellency the Governor of Andhra Pradesh and Hon'ble Chancellor of A.P. State Universities has requested the Vice-Chancellors to take stringent action on the ragging incidents and take all precautionary steps to curb Ragging in Educational Institutions. A copy of the material is enclosed herewith again.


Further, I am to bring to you notice that the Council has developed five short films depicting the ill effects of ragging and sent the CDs to all the Universities and Colleges for its screening in the campuses of the Universities/Colleges.

It is painful to note that still some ragging incidents have been reported. Hence it may be appropriate to direct all colleges under the university jurisdiction to take all precautionary measures for prohibition of ragging in Colleges and also outside the colleges especially in hostels. Wide publicity through Print and Electronic Media, Pamphlets, Banners, Notices etc. is required to be given. You are requested to conduct meetings with the senior students and people from the Academic Institutions, Judiciary, Police Department etc., on the Act provisions and guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the UGC on the issue of ragging.

I request you to kindly take personal interest in the matter and take urgent action by issuing necessary instructions to all the university and affiliated Colleges directing them to comply with the guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, Regulations of the UGC, State Act Provisions etc., to see to it that 2011-12 would be a ragging-free academic year.
